Born in Jaipura (Doraha) Ludhiana
Completed Bachelor of Science at Punjab University

1960

Married Satpaljit Kaur and moved to Modeltown, Ludhiana
Started his career as a Science Teacher at Rara Sahib High School

1960-66

Started his career in the panchayat development department as a civil servant and developing a close relationship Dr BS. Shokar eye specialist and surgeon from Vienna, Austria. They joined forces to carry out free eye camps (treatments to surgeries).

1966-79

BDO in 1966 in districts Kharad, Dera Bassi, Moga, Hoshiapur
DDPO in 1979 in districts Ropar, Hoshiapur, Ludhiana

1982-92

Setup of the first prosthetic centre in North India,
with w/o General Daulat Singh.

One of his biggest achievements was to set up the largest health camps in Zirakpur. He initiated the 'Chandigarh Medical Fair' in 1992 which involved the check-up of 2000 patients from 25 specialist doctors, led by Dr Chautani (Director of Health PGI Chandigarh) offering free food/medical advice/surgeries. On completion, Development Minister Atma Singh awarded him a 'Commendation for Outstanding Social Work' and issued all Punjab Development Officers to run similar camps.

Retired as Secretary Zila Prishad in 1992.

2015-2023

His dream was to open a charitable hospital under his mother's name. The dispensary was then upgraded to a hospital consisting of a team of ten offering free blood tests/x-rays/ECG and general GP services.
